### **CONTIGO AUTOSEAL**

Early morning golf means early morning coffee. How many times have I done it and seen it: coffee cup in the golf cart tray and, oops!, the cart hits a bump and there goes coffee spilling over the top or through the hole in the container. So much for a fresh start!

I recently found the answer to this challenge in the Contigo Autoseal stainless steel travel mug. What's different about this mug is that it automatically seals between sips, making it the only travel mug you cannot spill!

I tested it right in front of my wife, filling the Autoseal Mug

with hot coffee. Then I walked right up to her and turned it upside down right in front of her, well, you know what. Talk about wonderment and anguish packaged into a split second!

No coffee came out. Not a spill. Why didn't the coffee go all over the place, or at least drip, she asked.

I explained that the only way the coffee comes out is when you press the trigger button as you hold the side of the cup in your hand. Once you take your finger off the button, the mug becomes locked, sealed, airtight and will never spill.

The Autoseal patented technology is 100 percent leak proof and is vacuum-insulated. Because it's "always closed" (except when you want to drink your coffee or beverage), hot beverages stay absolutely hot for four hours, while cold liquids stay cold for 12 hours.

I've never seen anything like this before because, fact is, there is nothing else on the market like the Contigo Autoseal Mug.

Autoseal Mugs are available at Target stores nationwide in the housewares department. Mug prices range from \$14.99 for the high impact thermo plastic to \$19.99 for the stainless steel version which I use.
